This is a temporary, non-pastoral engagement and is not a trial pastorate.

What You'll Do

- Preach during assigned Sunday worship services
- Prepare biblically sound, relevant messages aligned with the church's annual theme calendar
- Collaborate with church leadership to ensure a meaningful worship experience
- Support a spirit of unity, encouragement, and consistency during the interim season

Schedule

- Engagements follow a consistent, pre-established schedule
- Ministers may be invited for one or multiple dates
- Return invitations are at the discretion of church leadership and do not imply permanence

Compensation

- Compensation to be determined, starting at \$200.00 Per Week.

Important Notes

- This role does not include pastoral authority, governance responsibilities, or administrative oversight
- This engagement does not constitute a trial or pathway to permanent pastoral leadership
- Ministers are expected to honor the church's worship culture and annual themes
